


The Elvetham 5km Walking and Running route: Map

Embark on our 5km walking and running route around the historic Elvetham estate.
A leisurely stroll through the Hampshire countryside.



Difficulty: Easy – The route is relatively flat but will require you to climb over fencing stiles along the way.
Duration: 1 hour (walking) – make sure to wear appropriate shoes.



The Elvetham 5km Walking and Running route: Directions

1. *Set out from The Elvetham main house and walk between the church, on your right, and the stables, on your left, towards the properties eastern gate. Open the gate and continue down the dirt track in front of you. *Towards the end of this track you will approach a gate just before North Lodge Cottage on your left, you can pass through this gate on your left hand side. Continue down the path until you come to a road. *Once at the road, use the road bridge to cross the river towards point 2.
2. *After the bridge immediately turn right down a rubble road, you will see two cottages on your left hand side. Just past the cottages you will see a gate in front of you. Go through this gate on the right hand side and follow the footpath around the side of the field towards point 3.
3. *Enter a second field and turn right, following the footpath on the side of the field. *You will come to the corner of the field with a wood and a small stream in front of you, to your right you will see a small wooden bridge, cross this bridge and follow the path around the side of the wood. *Continue along this path towards point 4.
4. *Here you will come across a barn on your left hand side, just pass this you will see a small track. Turn right at this track following the above power lines towards point 5.
5. At this point you are now half way. *You will have joined back up with the river follow the river until you come across a wide wooden bridge with a large log lying in front of it. Cross this bridge and continue to follow the river until you arrive at large house with a surrounding wall. *Before this house, to your right you will see a country road. Follow this road towards point 6 and look out for a farmer's stile hidden in the hedges on the right hand side.
6. *Cross over this stile and walk along the path through the centre of the next two fields. *At the end of the second field there will be a third field where the path continues. Follow this path keeping the hedge on your left hand side towards point 7. You will pass the Elvetham Old Rectory on your left hand side.
7. *At this point you will come to a road. On the opposite side of the road, in front of the house on your left, you will see another farmer's stile. Cross over this stile and walk through the field towards a copse of fir trees. *Follow the path through the fir trees to the final field, there are stiles at either end of the trees. *Follow the path through the final field towards the back of The Elvetham Church and pass over the final stile.
